## **South Bend physician to represent state's largest physician organization as AMA alternate delegate**

INDIANAPOLIS – Brent W Mohr, M.D., a rheumatology specialist with the South Bend Clinic and Surgicenter, LLP, was elected by physician members of the Indiana State Medical Association (ISMA) to serve as one of their alternate delegates to the American Medical Association (AMA). Dr. Mohr now begins serving a one-year term in his new position.

A native of Rushville, Dr. Mohr just completed a term as president of the ISMA, the state's largest physician organization. Previously, he chaired the ISMA's Board of Trustees, comprised of elected trustees and alternates from the organization's 13 Indiana districts. He was also president of the St. Joseph County Medical Society and the ISMA's 13<sup>th</sup> District Medical Society.

Physician delegates from around Indiana voted for Dr. Mohr on Sunday, Sept. 18, during the ISMA's 162<sup>nd</sup> Annual Convention in Indianapolis. The statewide physician organization currently has approximately 8,000 members.

Since 1849, the ISMA has represented Indiana physicians, promoting sound health care policy in the public, private and governmental sectors and working to support continuing medical education for the state's doctors.
