## **Area physician to serve as alternate member of physician organization's Board of Trustees**

INDIANAPOLIS – Lafayette's Scott Sanders, M.D., a neurologist with Indiana Neuro-Ophthalmology & Center for Balance, has started a three-year term as an alternate on the Indiana State Medical Association (ISMA) Board of Trustees. Dr. Sanders represents the ISMA's 9<sup>th</sup> District that includes Benton, Boone, Clinton, Fountain, Jasper, Hamilton, Montgomery, Newton, Tippecanoe, Tipton, Warren and White counties.

The ISMA Board is composed of representatives from 13 districts in the state and three subsidiary societies. Dr. Sanders was elected by members of his district to serve a three-year term that expires in 2014.

Established in 1849, the ISMA today has approximately 8,000 physician members from every county in Indiana. The organization works to promote sound health care policy in the public, private and governmental sectors and to support continuing medical education for the state's physicians.
