### Program Description

As the nation's healthcare expenditures continue to mount, policy-makers and payers repeatedly push for increased efficiency and value-added systems to control costs and improve outcomes. Mental health and substance abuse assessments and interventions are separated from general medical care by the payment mechanics of health plans and government programs. It is well known that psychiatric and emotional issues have a significant impact on the physical health of individuals, yet little is done to coordinate total care needs and improve overall health outcomes. This conference will provide a discussion of the dynamics of our current broken system and why change is difficult and evolutionary. Our featured speakers will advance the call for a reorganization of our healthcare system to re-integrate psychiatric care into the world of general medical care.
