In 1999, the Indiana State Medical Association established the Patient Health Advocate Award. This annual award is presented to a non-physician who has made great contributions to the health and well-being of Hoosier patients.

Deadline for submission: July 19, 2019

Nomination Criteria

- 1. The nominee must be a non-physician.
- 2. Candidates must be nominated by any physician member of the ISMA.
- 3. ISMA must receive documentation demonstrating the candidate's contribution to the health and well-being of Indiana citizens.

Nomination Process

A panel of three ISMA past-presidents will review the nominations and select the recipient.

The award honoring the achievement will be presented during ISMA's annual meeting of the House of Delegates in September.

- 1. A current biography of the nominee
- 2. Your letter of recommendation outlining the contributions by the nominee
 - Include information confirming service was provided
 - Outline the reasons you believe this nominee deserves to receive this award
- 3. Any articles highlighting the nominee's contribution to the health of Indiana citizens
