[Backline for Telehealth](#) is a secure messaging and clinical communication platform created by DrFirst and available to ISMA members at an annual cost of \$300 per user.

About Backline for Telehealth

- Screen patients for coronavirus without risk of exposure for you or your staff.
- Can be used for any office visit.
- Communications features such as patient tracking and billing.
- Visits initiated by a simple text from clinician.
- No patient registration process.
- No app to download.
- No usage limits or per-session fees.
- Share information among staff, family members, caretakers and outside providers in real time.
- HIPAA-compliant.

Backline can be used to improve care collaboration in nearly every setting, including physician practices, hospitals, long-term care facilities, emergency medical services, hospices and pharmacies. Physicians and allied health care professionals can use the platform's HIPAA-compliant secure messaging and telehealth capability to confer with other clinicians.
