The Store It Safe (SIS) Quality Improvement (QI) Project will help simplify safe storage guidance and suicide prevention practices through a unique collaboration between the Ohio and Indiana AAP chapters.

Our goal is to expand Store It Safe to new regions across Indiana to protect more children and families.

Since launching in Indiana, Store It Safe has engaged 16 practices and 109 pediatric providers.

WHY IT MATTERS



Firearms kill

more children and teens than any other cause including car crashes and cancer.



85% of unintentional firearm injury deaths occur at home.

82% of youth firearm-related suicides involve a firearm owned by a household member.

ADOLESCENT TRACK (12-21 YRS)

- ✔ Depression screening
- ✔ Suicidality screening
- ✔ Lethal Means Restriction Counseling (LMRC)



YOUNG CHILD TRACK (2-5 YRS)

- ✔ Screening
- ✔ Safe storage resources
- ✔ Lethal Means Restriction Counseling (LMRC)



Participating practices will receive:

- 25 points of MOC IV credit
- \$500 clinic stipend
- Educational resources in multiple languages for patients and families
- Lockboxes for families
- iPads for efficient and streamlined data entry
- Convenient virtual education sessions and practice coaching
